Aboriginal Family Literacy supports the family and community in strengthening literacy across the generations. It can include:

- Aboriginal values
- Cultural teachings
- Aboriginal languages
- Traditional practices on the land



Young Aboriginal children experience literacy with their family and in their community

Literacy learning takes place in **daily life** – in **multiple forms** – and is deeply connected to how we understand the world.

Families together can:

1. Use Aboriginal languages when together (prayers, counting, introductions, messages, etc.).
2. Make and talk about regalia
3. Tell traditional stories
4. Make traditional foods from family recipes
